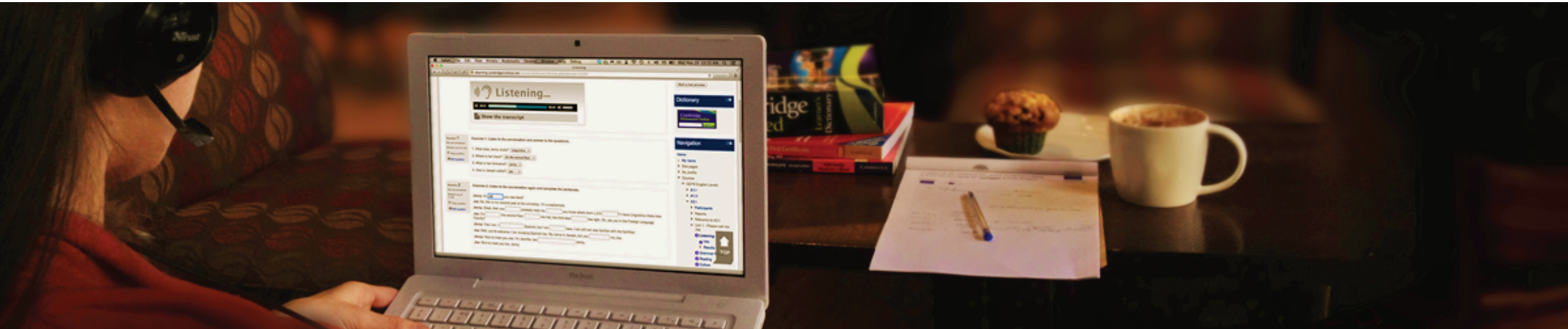

## HOW TO STUDY THIS COURSE?

Dear student,

Welcome to your online course provided by Cambridge Institute. Please read the following instructions carefully, so you can make the best out of your course and learn Goethe's language.

Our course complies with the standards of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) and is currently available for basic levels – A1.I and A1.II.

Our platform alternates theory and practical exercises. The whole course is developed in the target language, that is, German. It is proven that this is best way to learn a foreign language and although it demands a little more effort in the beginning, its results are more lasting and effective.

On the right-sided bar you will find the Collins Online Dictionary to help you with any difficult word/expression you might need to translate to English.

Also, some technical aspects to take into account:



- Do not include full stop/period (.) in words or sentences you write in gaps. If you do so, the system will not recognize your answer as correct.
- You are allowed **unlimited attempts** in all exercises/quizzes, **except** the ones that require **recording your voice**. These exercises are limited to 5 attempts. Please note that these exercises are not corrected by the system, but by a teacher. Therefore, we ask you to please wait for the correction and feedback before you do the next attempt, so you can take full profit of all 5 attempts given.

The course is organized in units/topics and each one helps you develop different language skills.


## THE ALPHABET


The first unit of the A1.I German course teaches you how to read /spell the alphabet in German.

## GRAMMAR

This section comes with an explanation box, where you can study the topic proposed and see some examples. This explanation is followed by exercises, which can be filling in the gaps, rewriting sentences, choosing the best/correct option, correct sentences or write short texts.
